

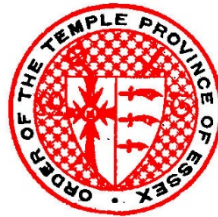

The Knights of Malta will assemble in the Temple.

1. The Provincial Sub-Prior accompanied by the Provincial Prelate will enter the Temple.
2. The Provincial Prior of the United Orders, R. E. Kt Anthony John Helliard, will enter the Temple in procession attended by Great Officers and visitors of distinction.

11.00 a.m.

3. A Provincial Priory of Malta will be opened.
4. Approved Candidates will be installed as Knights of St. Paul and the Mediterranean Pass communicated by V. E. Kt Ray Clare.
5. Visitors will be welcomed by the Right Eminent Provincial Prior of the United Orders.
6. The Provincial Vice-Chancellor will call the Muster Roll of the Priories of Essex. On the name of each being called, Knights who are members of that Priory will rise and salute.
7. The Minutes of the previous meeting, having been printed and circulated, will be put for confirmation.
8. The Treasurer's Report and Statement of Accounts will be received and a proposition made that they be adopted and entered on the Minutes.
9. The Knights of St. Paul will be admitted to the Order of Malta under the direction of the Provincial Sub-Prior, E. Kt. Roger Langdon Smith.
10. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior will address the Knights.
11. Communications will be received and any other Provincial Priory business transacted.
12. Alms will be collected, during which the Knights of Malta Hymn will be sung.
13. Provincial Priory of Malta will be closed.
14. The first verse of the National Anthem will be sung.
15. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior will retire in procession, together with visitors of distinction.
