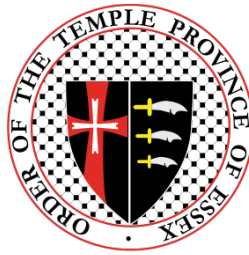

Regalia: All Knights will wear the Full Habit of the Order

10.45 a.m.

1. The Knights Templar, Great Officers and Provincial Officers of the year to be seated in the Temple.
2. The Provincial Prelate and Provincial Almoner will enter the Temple in procession.
3. The Knights of the Malta Deputation will enter the Temple in procession under the Arch of Steel.
4. Heads of Orders and distinguished Guests will enter the Temple in procession under the Arch of Steel.
5. GCT, KCT, Provincial Priors, Provincial Sub Priors and Provincial Vice-Chancellors will enter the Temple in procession under the Arch of Steel.
6. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior and the Eminent Provincial Sub-Prior will enter the Temple in procession under the Arch of Steel.

7. Provincial Priory will be opened.
8. The Provincial Vice Chancellor will call the Muster Roll. On the name of each Preceptory being called, the Knights belonging to that Preceptory will rise and salute.
9. The Visitors will be welcomed by the Right Eminent Provincial Prior and saluted.
10. Requiem in memory of Knights of the Province who have died during the year.
11. The Minutes of the meeting held on the 10th May 2018, having been printed and circulated will be put for confirmation.
12. The Provincial Vice-Chancellor will read any communications.
13. The Provincial Vice-Chancellor will give his report.
14. The Provincial Treasurer and an Auditor will be elected.
15. The Provincial Benevolent Fund Trustees will be elected
16. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior will appoint and invest his Officers for the ensuing year.
17. Provincial Officers will be saluted.
18. Demonstration of Sword Drill by members of the Provincial Prior's Bodyguard.
